
Litigation Survey... Over 500 Businesses

- Over the past 5 years, 44% of respondents had claims they did not pursue
- Some of the potential claims exceeded \$100,000
- Of the reasons given for not pursuing claims, 60% cited cost and 57% cited time – only 15% believed their claim was questionable

Litigation Survey... Over 500 Businesses


• When asked what is most important outcome in resolving disputes, businesses clearly value settlement over winning:

Business Litigation . . . A Good–Size Industry in Itself

 One report estimates that over \$200 billion is spent in litigation by Fortune 500 companies – over 1/3 of annual net profit



Spending – \$ Billions


Cost of Resolving Contract Disputes. . . Mediation Costs a Fraction of Other Choices

Estimated Cost Per Party of Contract Dispute



- Litigation 36 mos., Median cost/party through trial NSCS
- Arbitration 14 mos., Can be higher than litigation, estimated 50%
- Private Mediation Under 1 mos., Lawyers optional, ½ Submission Fee \$250, ½ Daily Mediator Fee \$2500

Business Litigation . . . Contract Case Filings Up 50% 2005 – 2010




Increase in Contract Case Filings Since 2001

Misallocating Resources . . . Business Litigation Rarely Has A Winner
